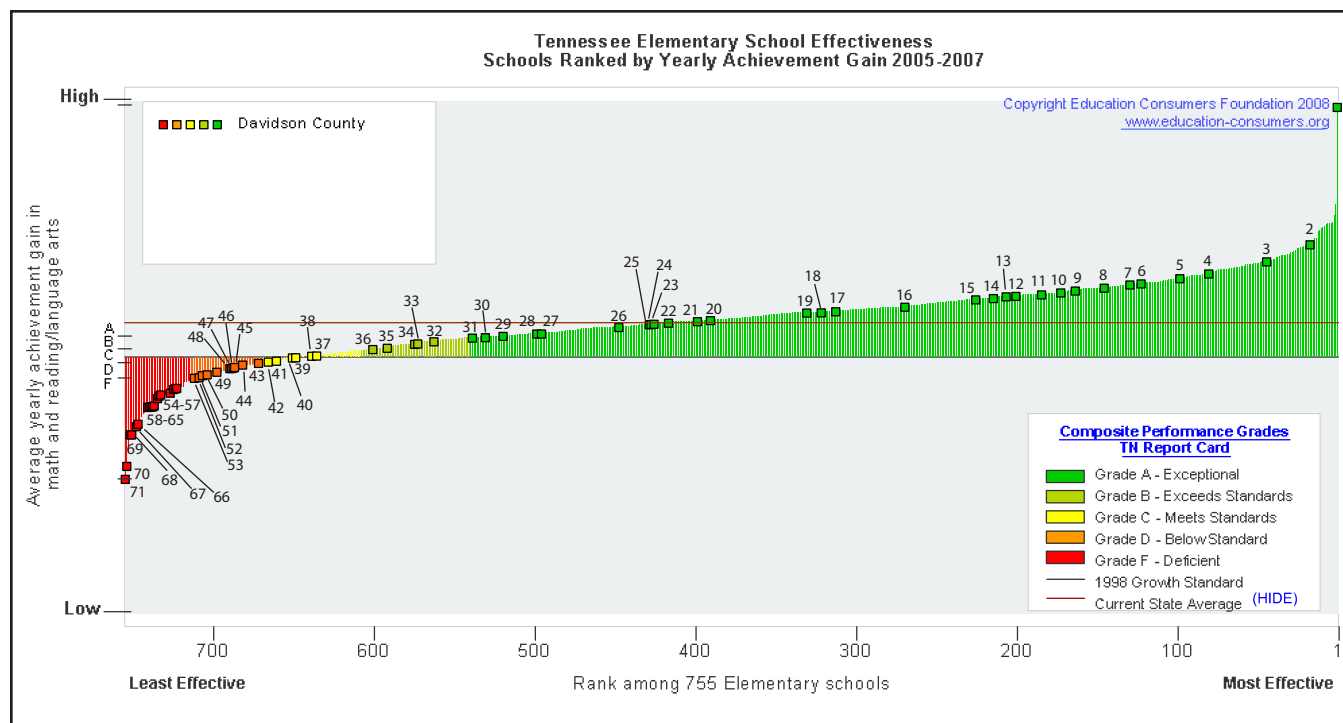

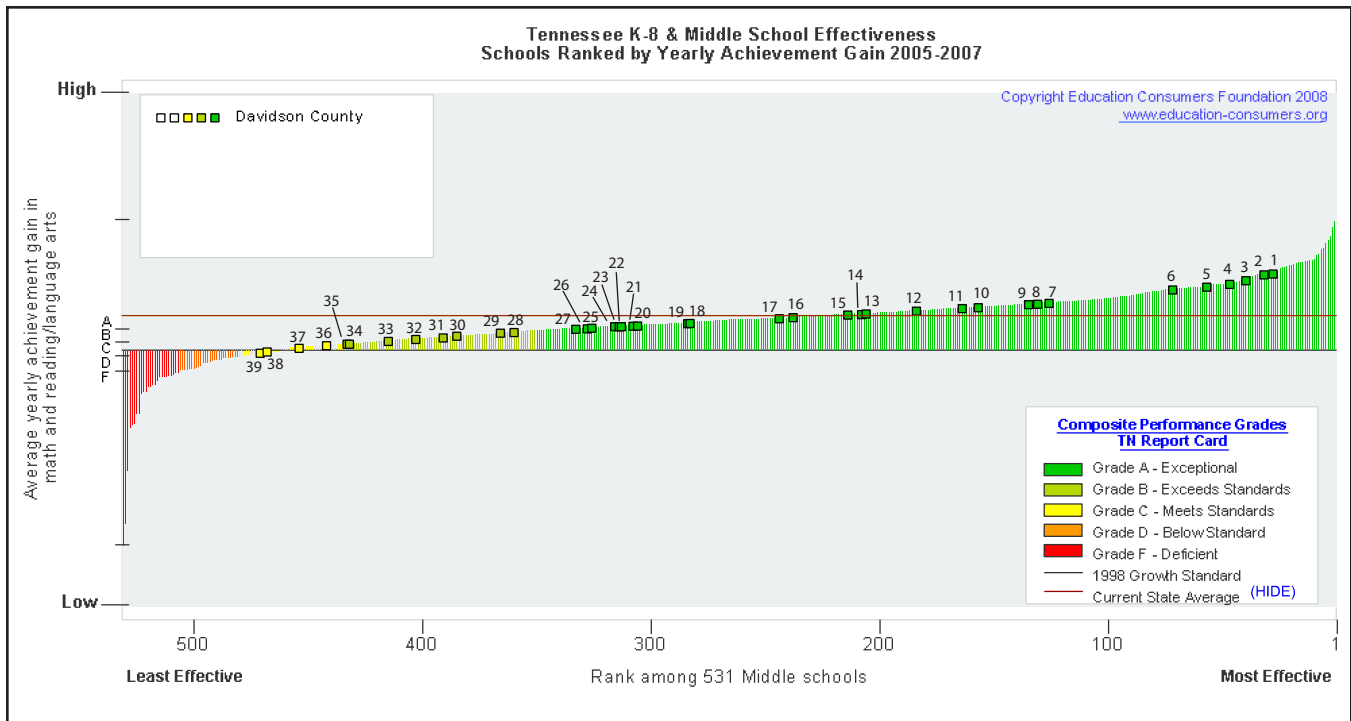

About These Charts and Tables

The chart on the opposite page, and the one found on the previous pages, are simply the value-added performance scores of Tennessee elementary and middle schools laid out in graphic format to make it easy to compare their relative effectiveness.

Each school is represented by a point on the chart, showing where it falls against others in the state. The score for each school comes from the three-year average of a school's value-added performance in reading and math, and the grading system also comes from the state.

All of the data in these charts comes from the Tennessee State Department of Education; ECF has not done any editorializing or introduced its own judgements.

The baseline of the chart represents the average value-added performance of Tennessee elementary and middle schools in 1998, which is the state's current gauge of progress. The two ranking numbers in the tables below each chart show how each school in Davidson County ranks against others in the county and then in the state. Schools are ranked from most effective to least effective.

Want to build your own School Performance Charts?

The charts in this brochure were printed directly from an interactive and intuitive program made available on the ECF website. It is a free resource for anyone interested in school performance, and one that we would encourage you to explore.

The charts allow you to select multiple schools and/or multiple districts to compare school performance; you can flag individual schools by name, move their names around for better layout, or

highlight the winners of ECF's Value-Added Achievement Awards. Once you've built your charts, you can print them to a single page or to a two-page format that can be used as a wall chart.

Charts are available with the most recent data from the state; you can also go back one or two years to review changes in performance over time. You can even look at an alternate view of the charts as if the current state average served as the baseline.
